What type?

Threat to public and/or environmental health

Non-threatening

REQUIRES IMMEDIATE CONTAINMENT:
 EXAMPLES:
 UNKNOWN discharges/substances
 HAZARDOUS materials
 "Reportable Quantity" releases
 Traffic accident discharges/Vehicle fluids


[RESPONDING DEPARTMENT] responsibilities:

[RESPONDING DEPARTMENT] responsibilities:

Coordinate as necessary with secondary responders to identify, contain, eliminate, and trace the source of the discharge (as applicable).
 For drinking water contamination concerns, call CITY WATER DEPARTMENT immediately at 330-489-3315

Do NOT complete a "Report for Illicit Discharge in MS4"

Perform necessary maintenance and any applicable record-keeping



1 City MS4 ("Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System") = Any City-owned/operated storm drainage system such as storm sewers, catch basins, roadside ditches/swales, culverts, detention/retention basins, etc. within City right-of-way/easement or on City property. "City MS4" does NOT include private storm drainage systems, drainage systems owned/operated by a township, Stark County, or another city, "waters of the state", or sanitary sewer systems.
 2 "water of the state" = Natural water bodies such as creeks, lakes, streams, ponds, wetlands, swamps, etc. that are not owned, maintained, or operated by the City.
 3 "private drainage system" = Any storm drainage system including storm sewers, catch basins, roadside ditches/swales, culverts, detention/retention basins, etc. that is NOT owned/maintained/operated by the City or another government jurisdiction.
